This is a comprehensive 64-hour program that teaches interpreters to work in health care, educational and social services. **Tuition cost for this training is \$750. Scholarships of up to \$650 are available.** Registration fee, language proficiency screening (English and target language), the manual and exercises/role plays are included in the cost. **Individuals interested in this training must complete the form below and include a nonrefundable registration fee** (which includes lg. proficiency screening) **of \$100 check or money order made out to SNHAHEC and mail it to: Florentina G.
