

YOUR VOTE IS YOUR VOICE

Don't let others speak for you!

What You Need to Register:

- **Proof of Identity:** Driver's license, non-driver's license, school or military ID, or valid passport
- **Proof of Address:** Proof of residence where you will vote, such as driver's license or non-driver's license, or utility bill with your name and address
- **Proof of Age:** Driver's license or non-driver's license, birth certificate or passport proving that you are or will be 18 years old on election day
- **Proof of Citizenship:** Naturalization certificate, birth certificate, or valid passport

If you do not have all of the documents requested, you may sign an affidavit and city officials will follow up to verify after the election.

Go to your city hall to register, or you can register on Election Day at the polls.
